PRE-ANESTHETIC INSTRUCTIONS

Procedure to be performed	Drop off Time:

- 1. No food for your cat after 10:00 pm the night before, and no food the morning of surgery. This will help prevent any vomiting that could occur while your cat is under anesthesia. Water is still ok.
- 2. Please bring your cat to the clinic at your scheduled appointment time the morning of surgery. If a specific time was not given to you, please come between 8:30 and 9:30 am. If a morning drop off time cannot be worked out, you may drop off your cat the night before with no additional charge so long as prior arrangements are made.
- 3. **Your cat must arrive and leave the clinic in a carrier**. This is the clinic policy. NO EXCEPTIONS! If you are bringing multiple cats/kittens on the same day and/or leaving on the same day you will need separate carries for each cat/kitten.

**For those kittens/cats being declawed, please make sure they have a soft towel or bed to ride on! **

JUST A FEW REMINDERS...

- Your cat's annual vaccinations must be current before we can hospitalize them. If they are coming up due or are overdue, in some cases we can update them while your cat is here.
- For kittens that are in the process of completing the vaccination series, they must be up-to-date to the appropriate vaccine in the series for their age.
- Should your cat experience any health concerns between when you made the appointment and the actual scheduled procedure date, (e.g. vomiting, diarrhea, etc) please be sure to let us know as soon as possible as this may delay the procedure to be performed.
